2017 LE LECCIAIA ROSSO DI MONTALCINO— Rosso di Montalcino consists of 100% Sangiovese grapes. It is considered the “Little Brother” of the region’s famous Brunello because it is aged for only one year instead of at least 3 years. It yields a fresh, medium bodied red.

2017 VILLA D’ANGELO VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO –Like Chianti and Rosso di Montalcino, it is also made primarily from sangiovese grapes but with a small percentage of canaiolo. An excellent choice-- fit for Royalty!
