As we know, Winter isn't over yet, so we thought some good full-bodied reds might be a good idea. The following wines are some that will accompany hearty Winter fare



**2013 SORDO BAROLO**—“The Wine of Kings and the King of Wines”, Barolo, from Piedmont in the northeast of Italy is considered one of Italy’s (and the world’s) greatest wines. Made from nebbiolo grapes, Sordo is an excellent example of a most reasonably priced Barolo, but don’t let the price fool you, it compares to wines costing 2 or 3 times more!

**2015 ANTICHE TERRE AMARONE**—A special wine made with sun-dried grapes which concentrate the flavor and power of this juice. Should be served with steaks or roasts or some sharp provolone ...heavenly!

**2014 DOMAINE LES GOUBERT GIGONDAS**—A less well-known wine from the Rhone region in the southwestern part of France. Very similar to its next-door neighbor, Chateauneuf-du-Pape, made from blends of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault and other grapes, yielding a rich full-bodied wine.

**2011 CHATEAU PLINCE (Pomerol)**—Although 2011 is not a “vintage of the century,” it has certainly produced a lot of fine wine for current drinking. The 2011 Chateau Plince is a prime example. A little lighter in body than the other wines we are presenting, we think it will be fine particularly with lamb. Imported to sell for \$40 to \$45 per bottle, we have agreed not to advertise our special price.
